

Gas Stations Fees

1. Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure Plan (for above ground tanks of oil exceeding 1320 gallons) is \$2000 to \$5000. The low range represents a site doing their own plan and having it signed off by an licensed engineer and the high end is if an engineer does the whole document.
2. Bay Area Air Quality Management District fees. The Air District fees are annual and based solely on emission sources. There is an initial filing fee \$109.11 per single gas nozzle or \$109.11 per product for multi-product nozzles; a permit to operate fee of \$41.79 per nozzle and many more fees for bulk plants, terminals, etc. that does not apply to biodiesel. Diesel is not regulated by them unless combusted-back up generators and other combustion sources.
3. Hazmat fees of \$159 as a base fee, \$301 per underground storage tank, \$263 to \$999 for above-ground storage tank, hazardous waste generator fee of \$80 to \$298 if repair shop, and state fees of \$39.

Minimum annual fees: approximately \$3000
