WHAT IS CONGESTION PRICING?

Congestion pricing is a program to manage our congested city streets. Motorists would be charged a user fee to drive in specific areas or routes during the most congested times of day. Motorists would choose to drive if the convenience is worth the fee, use alternatives like transit, or drive at a different time of day.

Fee revenues would be invested in transportation alternatives and improvements benefiting all travelers, including drivers, transit riders, carpoolers, bicyclists, and pedestrians.
