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### Elements

- Small Business Direct Install
  - Walk-in businesses
  - Lighting and Refrigeration
  - Ecology Action is implementing contractor
- Commercial and Multifamily PLUS
  - Property owners, office buildings, institutions, warehouses, etc.
  - Lighting, Refrigeration, Heating and Cooling, Food Service, Hot Water, Computer Networks
  - Staff + ICF providing implementation support
  - 30+ participating installation contractors

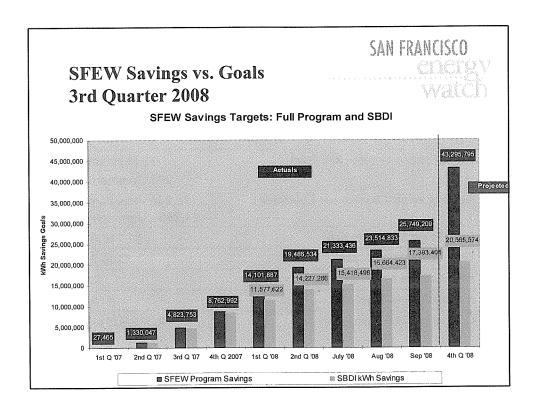
