Potential policy options for consideration by the Policy Committee of the  
San Francisco Commission on the Environment  
December 14, 2009

1. Federal Government should conduct a review of the safety standards and revise these based on concerns for children and long term exposure/effects.
2. City/County should require point of sale information on SAR values of cell phones that are as visible to the consumer as the price.
3. City/County should call on the School District to educate students and parents about cell phone radiation and restrict the use of cell phones and cell phone promotion in elementary schools.
4. City/County should adopt an ordinance requiring all cell phones be sold with a head-set.
5. Under the Precautionary Purchasing Ordinance the Director of the Department of the Environment should require City purchase of cell phones provide headset and outreach materials on minimizing exposure to radiation.
6. Department of the Environment staff should create a web page that will help consumers identify low SAR value phones and educate consumers about protective measures around cell phone radiation exposure.
