Similarly, I would also propose the large Elderberry at the top of Folsom Street on Bernal Hights for inclusion. It also is the largest publicly accessible one of its kind that I have seen in the City;

Lastly, please include the two Flowering Ash Trees in front of the Bernal Heights Branch of the Publica Library for inclusion as well. They are currently among the largest of their kind on our City streets. They also deserve more loving care to bring out the best of their neglected structure.
