### San Francisco Urban Gleaning Project

The BOS except and Expend to use grant funds was introduced this week and will be heard without committee reference at the next full BOS meeting. Staff is coordinating and partnering with other gleaning programs in the city. Current focus is on data organization strategies. Garden for the Environment is developing curriculum for the project. We have applied for fruit tree plantings with the Local Carbon Fund and working with the Mayor's office and other stakeholders to meet the Mayor's Food Policy Directives.

Tree Map work has restarted. Staff is being paid in IOU's until October.

### Urban Forest Plan

The Commission on the Environment requested information from Planning on the status of the UF Plan in a meeting held last week. The Commission will be hearing a resolution requesting the Planning Department place the UF Plan work as a highest priority item. A draft of that resolution has been added to your meeting packet. The Commission hearing where this item will be discussed will be on August 28<sup>th</sup>.
